


We still are in need of people willing to serve on our Welcome Team as greeters or as a host/hostess for The Gathering Place. If you would be willing to serve and didn't serve last

cup chopped pecans

1 egg

#### **Topping**

2 eggs ½ cup (1 stick) butter, 1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened 3½ cups 10X

powdered sugar

Preheat oven to 350°F. Mix together first four ingredients until combined. Press into a greased 9x13" pan. For topping, blend eggs, cream cheese and powdered sugar until smooth. Spread evenly on top of crust mixture. Bake at 350° for 35-45 minutes until golden brown. Do not overbake.


