


GriefShare is open to anyone experiencing grief due to loss of a loved one. You are welcome to join anytime throughout these dates.

IHS

This sacred monogram originally appeared as "IHC," the first three letters of "IHCOYC," the Greek word for Jesus. Over time the Greek "C" was replaced by the Latin "S" to become "IHS." There are many interpretations given to the letters "IHS," including the Latin "lesus Hominum Salvator" (Jesus, Savior of Men) and the English "I (Christ) Have Suffered."

Recipe—Red Magic Meat Loaf



1½ lbs. lean ground beef

1 cup soft bread crumbs

cup ketchup

1 egg, slightly beaten

½ tsp. salt tsp. pepper

¼ cup ketchup

1/4 cup chopped onion 1/4 cup crushed pineapple, drained

Preheat oven to 350°F. Combine first 7 ingredients. Form into a loaf (8"x4"x1½") and place in a greased shallow baking pan. Bake for 40 minutes. Combine the ¼ cup ketchup with pineapple and spoon over loaf. Bake 30 minutes longer. Let stand for 5 minutes before slicing.






